

ROSALEE CEMENT PRIMER SOLVENT THINNABLE

> Scope

By and large, cement surfaces are alkaline. Therefore, any primer to be applied on a cement surface must be alkali proof. This is possible by using only those resins (in the primer or paint) which have nil acid value. Solvent thinnable cement primer is based on such resins and hence is the ideal primer for cement surfaces.

> Areas of Application

Any cement concrete surface or asbestos cement sheets, which may have hair cracks or which is micro porous. The primer is required to fill up such surface defects.

> Surface Preparation

The surface must be free from oil, grease, dust and moisture. Light dry sand papering may be done.

Directions for Use

Stir the primer well. Add thinner for brushing viscosity and brush, using cross lap method. Dry sand, using fine sand paper, after 24 hours.

> Notes

The solvent thinnable primer is not recommended on freshly made cement surface, because they are pretty moist.
